DAY 1: ACCRA – CAPE COAST

Depart to explore the historic Denkyira Kingdom, particularly **Kakum National Park**. Kakum is one of West Africa's surviving tropical rain forests, spanning over 360sq km and filled with diverse and dense vegetation. A blend of true rainforest and semi deciduous forest, Kakum is the home to over 40 large mammals, 400 bird species and an array of butterflies, flora and fauna.

The most popular attraction in the forest is the **canopy walkway** which is made up of seven bridges extending 330m and hanging 40m above the forest floor. You will be given the choice to walk the canopy or enjoy a 2km nature walk through the forest to discover the wide variety of exotic floral species and the medicinal values they offer.

After lunch, visit the **Cape Coast Castle** which was built by the Swedes in 1653 and later taken over by the British. This castle also houses the West African Historical Museum, established by the Smithsonian Institute in collaboration with the Ghanaian Government in 1994. Later check in at your hotel.

DAY 2: CAPE COAST - ACCRA

After check-out and a hearty breakfast, visit the **Elmina Castle** Built by the Portuguese in 1482 as St. George's Castle. This castle was the first European structure built in Sub-Saharan Africa. Later check in at your hotel. Late afternoon, depart for the scenic drive back to Accra.

Welcome to this exciting '7 Bridges to the Coast' tour to the Central Region of Ghana! We are thrilled to have the opportunity to be your host for this adventure and will do all we can to ensure that it will be a memorable experience for you. We have drawn up a detailed itinerary (adjacent to this page) so you know exactly what each day entails. Here are some travel tips that you should be aware of before you travel:

THE TRIP

The total journey time from Accra to Cape Coast takes approximately two and a half (2.5) hours. The time for departure is 8.00 am. We ask all passengers to arrive at least fifteen (15) minutes before departure time. The pickup/drop-off point will be the front parking lot at the U.S Embassy, in Cantonments. The return portion of this trip, on the last day, will take approximately two and a half (2.5) hours as well.

CLOTHING

You will be doing lots of walking, we recommend light weight casual clothing, comfortable shoes and a hat to protect you from the sun's rays. We also recommend you bring along insect repellent. If you would like to swim, bring along a bathing suit to enable you take advantage of the swimming pools.

FOOD

We suggest that you bring along snacks, soft drinks and water for the trip, you will spend some time on the road. You can bring along lunch, or purchase lunch when the vehicle makes brief stops on the journey. The menus at the hotel and restaurants offer local Ghanaian dishes and continental cuisine.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Some West Africans do not wish to be photographed, while others are quite happy to be photographed. Please consult your guide if you want to take a photograph.
